**ORDER**

On October 30, 2020, Plaintiff Jonathan O. Hafen (Receiver) filed a Motion for Permission to Return Consigned Items (the “Motion”) (ECF No. 359). The Receiver requests that the court authorize the Receiver to return property belonging to Lindsay Curtis, Wright Thurston, and Glen Stacey. The Receiver bases his motion on his determination that Lindsay Curtis and Wright Thurston had valid consignment agreements with Defendant Rust Rare Coin

and that Glen Stacey purchased and paid for identified goods prior to the appointment of the Receiver.

On November 2, 2020, the court issued an order establishing an objection procedure for the Motion and directing the Receiver to lodge all objections timely received (within 30 days) with the court. That 30-day deadline has passed, and the Receiver has not received any objections or communications about the Motion.

Based on the reasons set forth in the Motion and the lack of objections, the Motion (ECF No. 359) is GRANTED.
