ADDITIONAL TIME**



Gaylen D. Rust, Denise G. Rust, and Joshua D. Rust (collectively Defendants), as well as R Legacy Racing Inc., R Legacy Entertainment LLC, and R Legacy Investments LLC (collectively, Relief Defendants and, collectively with Defendants, Receivership Defendants), moves the court for additional time. (ECF No. 456.) The Receiver requests additional time to investigate the proposed settlement agreement with Lynn and Darlene Goodsell. After submitting the Motion to Approve Receiver's Settlement Agreement with Lynn and Darlene Goodsell, (ECF No. 452.), the Receiver obtained additional information related to the Goodsell's assets, which potentially calls into question the agreed-upon settlement amount.

The court GRANTS the motion for additional time to investigate the matter. The Receiver is to notify the court within forty five (45) days from the date of this order regarding the status of the settlement.
