
Before the court is Receiver Jonathan O. Hafen's Motion Seeking Approval to Assist in Distribution of Class Action Settlement. (ECF No. 462.) The Receiver asks the court for permission to help administer a settlement in a related class-action case: Gregory v. Zions Bancorporation, Case No. 2:19-cv-00015-HCN-DBP. The court finds that allowing this would ultimately conserve Receivership Estate assets.

Based on the Motion, and for good cause appearing, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that:

1. The Motion is GRANTED;
2. The Receiver is authorized to receive any claims forms from the Class Action settlement class members who did not previously submit timely, valid Claim Forms in connection with the claims process previously approved by this Court (ECF No. 239);
3. The Receiver may apply his existing claims-analysis methodology as approved by this court and as implemented by the previously approved Claims Resolution Procedures (ECF No. 460) to determine the amount, if any, of each Class Action settlement class member's recognized loss;
4. The Receiver is authorized to issue and mail payments to Class Action settlement class members from the Class Action Settlement Fund consistent with the final Claims determinations reached through the Claims Resolution Procedures established by this court and the settlement distribution plan approved by the court in Gregory v. Zions Bancorporation, Case No. 2:19-cv-00015-HCN-DBP; and
5. The Receiver is authorized to perform such other and further actions as are necessary and appropriate to assist in the distribution of the Class Action Settlement Fund.
